






KEY FEATURES OF THE COUNTRY PROGRAMME (CP)

- The CP is UNIDO's programmatic service to support Members States in accelerating inclusive and sustainable industrial development (ISID) through planning and implementation of technical cooperation and other services, based on national development priorities, as well as UNIDO's comparative advantage and expertise
- The CP is accompanied by a resource mobilization strategy and funds for its implementation need to be mobilized; CP budget is indicative and depends on successful resource mobilization work

UNIDO FIELD OFFICE IN ARMENIA

The PMU is led by the CP Programme Manager and the UNIDO Country Representative in Armenia and supplemented by the group of experts

Daily work from the UNIDO headquarters and on the ground

KEY TASKS:

- Coordinate and support all the CP-related activities, including funds administration, implementation, monitoring, evaluation, coordination, etc.
- Conduct communication and outreach activities
- Collect and store all the data for result-based management and reporting

NATIONAL COORDINATION BODY (NCB)

CO-CHAIR FROM UNIDO

CO-CHAIR FROM THE GOVERNMENT OF ARMENIA

Members of the NCB include representatives of line ministries of Armenia that are appointed by the Government, UNIDO's technical focal points and other development partners

Meeting at least once a year to provide strategic guidance on priority actions, resource mobilization activities and exercise the overall oversight

KEY TASKS:

- Ensure institutional support required from each participating entity to efficiently achieve the identified objectives
- Promote and facilitate inter-ministerial cooperation for the implementation of projects and activities within the CP
- Ensure sustainability and complementarity of CP activities
- Enable the comprehensive implementation of the Resource Mobilization Strategy
