Overall objective

The project is aiming to promote the agro-tourism in the partners' regions and to improve the quality of the services provided by introducing a common specific quality standard and a certification process.

## Achieved results:

- Improved quality of services provided by agrotourism sector in partner countries through introduction of standardization and certification system.
- Based on the results of the current situation study and best practice analysis at international level common standard framework of agro-tourism criteria has been created - adapted it to the local specific conditions.
- A common assessment and a certification process have been developed, a group of local experts group of experts that will be able to support the local businesses and to apply the whole process in the partners' regions.
- A pilot application of the standard and certification scheme has been developed in several enterprises in the agro-tourism sector that will improve their services and act as role models in their areas.
- Created a CerTour certification system for a sustainable management of the pre-design period.
