## Description of the projects

**Overall Objective:** To achieve a stronger regional partnership and cooperation to realize significant improvements of the wastewater treatment facilities management in the Black Sea coastal states.

- Expert knowledge on the situation of wastewater management and sustainable development was increased in the Black Sea region;
- New concept was developed to improve the management of wastewaters treatment facilities in 6 countries, with direct access to the Black Sea or clearly integrated to the BS Basin;
- Wastewaters treatment facilities' performance was increased by implementing the CIS concept in Romania, Region of South-East and in Greece, Anatoliki Makedonia – Thraki Region.
