Achieved results:

- Support to communities in the region to develop local economies, to address environmental issues and strengthen people-to-people contacts;
- Assessment of urban development issues, policies and capacities in partner countries and as a result 3 cities from each participating country were selected which were more actively involved in further activities;
- Support was provided to the selected communities Local Governments for capacity building in the area of urban planning. During the international seminar and tour organized in Romania the participants got acquainted with the Romanian experience of the integrated urban development approach and its implementation;
- The project participants with the help of the experts developed the urban development plans of their communities using “The integrated urban development guideline” that was developed in the framework of the Project;
- At the end of the project an international conference was organized in Yerevan which led to establishment of Black Sea Region integrated urban development specialists’ network.
